

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-04

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 6.010 OF THE CENTERVILLE
FEE SCHEDULE REGARDING CEMETERY FEES AND THE PURCHASE
OF NICHE WALL SPACES**

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Section 6.010 of the Centerville Fee Schedule to amend the requirements and restrictions regarding the purchase of niche wall spaces as more particularly provided herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the proposed amendments to the Centerville Fee Schedule are desirable to allow residents to purchase a niche wall spaces.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
CENTERVILLE CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Amendment. Footnote 3 of Section 6.010 of the Centerville Fee Schedule regarding the purchase of a Niche Space and a Right of Inurnment in the Cemetery is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

3. Residents may only purchase a Right of Burial ~~or Right of Inurnment~~ on an immediate need basis; provided, at the time of need two Rights of Burial ~~or Inurnment~~ may be purchased. Residents may purchase a maximum of two Niche Spaces on a pre-need basis and one Niche Space on an immediate need basis at the time of need. One Niche Space can contain up to two sets of cremains if qualified in accordance with applicable City ordinances and regulations. Non-residents are not eligible or permitted to purchase a Right of Burial or a Niche Space ~~Right of Inurnment~~ in the cemetery at this time.

Section 2. Severability Clause. If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
