

## RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03

### A RESOLUTION AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE CENTERVILLE FEE SCHEDULE TO PROVIDE CURRENT EMPLOYEES RESIDENT STATUS FOR PURPOSES OF CERTAIN FEES

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to amend various sections of the Centerville Fee Schedule in order to provide current employees resident status for purposes of certain fees as more particularly provided herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the proposed amendments to the Centerville Fee Schedule are desirable and beneficial to provide current employees with resident status for purposes of certain fees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
CENTERVILLE CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Amendment.** Footnote 1 to Section 6.010 of the Centerville Fee Schedule regarding the definition of “resident” for purposes of Cemetery and Burial Fees is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

1. As used herein, the term “Resident” shall be defined as:
  - a. Any person who was domiciled within the corporate limits of Centerville City, Utah, at the time of death, regardless of actual place of death; or
  - b. Any person owning real property within the corporate limits of Centerville City, Utah, at the time of death, regardless of the residence or domicile of such person; or
  - c. Any person who was a legal resident of Centerville, Utah, at the time of death, regardless of domicile; ~~or~~
  - d. Any person who was formally domiciled within the corporate limits of Centerville City, Utah, immediately prior to moving from the City for the purpose of becoming domiciled in any facility for the purpose of receiving medical or residential care; or
  - ~~d.e. Any current employees of Centerville City and their immediate family members living in the same household.~~

**Section 2. Amendment.** Section 15.020 of the Centerville Fee Schedule regarding Park Pavillion Fees is hereby amended to add a new Footnote 4 regarding the definition of “Resident” and a new Footnote 5 regarding the definition of “Non-resident” to read as follows:

4. As used herein, the term “Resident” shall be defined as:
  - a. Any person who is a legal resident of Centerville; or
  - b. Any current employees of Centerville City and their immediate family members living in the same household.
5. As used herein, the term “Non-resident” shall be defined as any person who does not meet the definition of “Resident” as set forth herein.

**Section 3. Enactment.** Section 15.040 of the Centerville Fee Schedule regarding Recreation Program Fees is hereby enacted to read in its entirety as follows:

**15.040. Recreation Program Fees**

Centerville City provides certain recreational programs on an annual, seasonal or limited basis. Such recreation program fees shall be determined by the Recreation Program Director and set forth on the City Website or other reasonable means of notice. For purposes of City recreational programs and fees, the term "Resident" shall be defined as: (1) any person who is a legal resident of Centerville; or (2) any current employees of Centerville City and their immediate family members living in the same household. For purposes of such programs and fees, the term "Non-resident" shall be defined as any person who does not meet the definition of "Resident" as set forth herein.

**Section 4. Amendment.** Section 16.010 of the Centerville Fee Schedule regarding Police Department Fees is hereby amended to add a new Footnote 1 regarding the definition of "Resident" and a new Footnote 2 regarding the definition of "Non-resident" to read as follows:

1. As used herein, the term "Resident" shall be defined as:
  - a. Any person who is a legal resident of Centerville; or
  - b. Any current employee of Centerville City and their immediate family members living in the same household.
2. As used herein, the term "Non-resident" shall be defined as any person who does not meet the definition of "Resident" as set forth herein.

**Section 5. Severability Clause.** If any section, part or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
