

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-19

**A RESOLUTION REPEALING SECTION 12.040 OF THE CENTERVILLE
FEE SCHEDULE REGARDING FIRE AND EMS IMPACT FEES**

WHEREAS, the City Council recently approved Ordinance No. 2017-25 repealing the Fire/EMS Impact Fees adopted and assessed by Centerville City to be replaced by the Fire/EMS Impact Fees adopted and assessed by the South Davis Metro Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Centerville Fee Schedule to eliminate and repeal the reference to Fire/EMS Impact Fees in Section 12.040 as repealed by Ordinance No. 2017-25; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
CENTERVILLE CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Repeal. Section 12.040 of the Centerville Fee Schedule is hereby repealed as of the effective date of the South Davis Metro Fire Service Area Fire/EMS Impact Fees on September 18, 2017.

Section 2. Severability Clause. If any section, part or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution, and all sections, parts and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and the repeal of the Fire/EMS Impact Fees set forth herein shall become effective on September 18, 2017.
