

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-05

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 2.010 OF THE CENTERVILLE
FEE SCHEDULE REGARDING PERMIT FEES FOR RAISING CHICKENS
AND RABBITS**

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Centerville Fee Schedule to eliminate the annual renewal fee for chicken and rabbit permits in accordance with recent Zoning Code Amendments regarding the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the proposed amendments to the Centerville Fee Schedule to eliminate the annual renewal fee for chicken and rabbit permits is in the best interest of the public and will simplify the process and costs for both citizens and the City regarding this permitted use.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
CENTERVILLE CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Amendment. Section 2.010 of the Centerville Fee Schedule regarding permit fees for raising chickens and rabbits is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows.

2.010 Chickens And Rabbits

The following fees shall apply to the raising of chickens and/or rabbits within the City.

Raising Chickens and/or Rabbits	Fee
Permit Fee (Initial Application)	\$20 \$10
Annual Renewal Fee	\$5

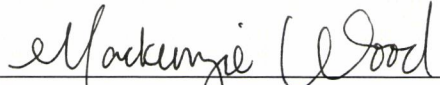

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

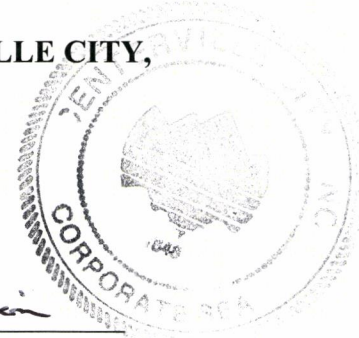

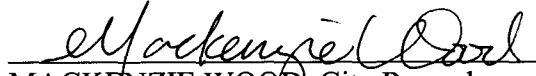
