

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.05.040 OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE UNIFORM FINE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted Section 1.05.040 of the Centerville Municipal Code regarding the Uniform Fine Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Section 1.05.040 of the Centerville Municipal Code to rename the Centerville Fine/Bail Schedule the "Centerville Fine Schedule" and to add a link to the Centerville Fine Schedule as more particularly set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CENTERVILLE CITY, STATE OF UTAH:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1.05.040 of the Centerville Municipal Code regarding the Uniform Fine Schedule is hereby amended to read in its entirety as set forth as follows.

1.05.040 Uniform Fine Schedule

Fines, forfeitures and surcharges for State law offenses may be imposed in accordance with the Uniform Fine/Bail Schedule adopted by the Utah Judicial Council in accordance with Utah Code § 76-3-301.5. Fines, forfeitures and surcharges for various local offenses may be imposed in accordance with the Centerville Fine/Bail Schedule for Local Ordinances as adopted by the City Council. The fines, forfeitures and surcharges set forth in such fine schedules shall not prohibit the court from, in its discretion, imposing no fine, or a fine in any amount up to and including the maximum fine for the offense. Section 2. Severability Clause. If any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all provisions, clauses and words of this Ordinance shall be severable. This Section shall become effective without codification.

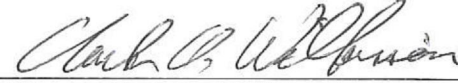
Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication or posting, or thirty (30) days after passage, whichever occurs first. In addition, pursuant to Utah Code § 10-3-705, all ordinances must be recorded by the City Recorder in a book used exclusively for that purpose before taking effect.
