

ORDINANCE 2005-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TERMS OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF THE ESCALANTE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

SECTION 1.

The Escalante City Planning and Zoning Commission, referred herein as the Commission, shall be comprised of seven members, one of whom shall be appointed from among the membership of the Escalante City Council.

SECTION 2.

The term of office of the Commission for the member of the City Council shall be two years and shall coincide with that member's term of office on the City Council.

The terms of office for the remaining six members of the commission shall be three years. Two terms of office shall expire each year.


SECTION 3.

The Commission shall recommend procedures for the orderly transition of terms of members of the Commission to the City Council for ratification within sixty days of passage of this act.

SECTION 4.



Any portion of any ordinance in conflict with this act is hereby repealed.
