

ORDINANCE NO. 1297

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF GLENN AMENDING THE GLENN COUNTY CODE BY AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.040, SECTION 2.040.030 RELATING TO SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF SUPERVISORS; AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3.060, SECTIONS 3.060.21 AND 3.060.22 RELATING TO SALARY RANGES FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND ADJUSTMENT TO SUPERVISORS' SALARIES; AND REPEALLING UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE NUMBER 1181 AND TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3.060, SECTION 3.060.23 RELATING TO SALARY UPON ELECTION OF SUPERVISORS

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GLENN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by amending Title 2, Chapter 2.040, Section 2.040.030 to read in its entirety as follows:

2.040.030 Salaries and Expenses of Supervisors.

A. On January 1 of each year or as soon thereafter as the board may deem appropriate, the Board of Supervisors will establish by ordinance the compensation of the supervisors. The chairman shall receive an additional \$100 per month more than other members of the Board of Supervisors. In the event the supervisors do not enact an annual ordinance adjusting salaries, the supervisors will continue to receive the compensation pursuant to the last valid enacted ordinance.

B. Members of the Board of Supervisors who opt out of Group Health Insurance Coverage shall receive a net monthly payment equivalent to ninety (90) percent of the employee only premium for the lowest cost health plan available, minus the amount the county must contribute to taxes, retirement contributions and other costs directly tied to salary. The board member must provide proof of health insurance coverage in order to qualify for this payment. This payment is not authorized for members who are eligible for Medicare Part A. This payment is not authorized for members whose health insurance is subsidized by the county.

C. Each supervisor shall receive, in a manner consistent with the methods for paying mileage for regular county employees, mileage expenses for miles traveled in the discharge of the supervisors' responsibilities. The rate at which mileage shall be reimbursed pursuant to this section shall be the current rate recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as exempt from taxation under the Internal Revenue Code.

D. Each supervisor shall be entitled to receive necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the supervisors' duties provided funds have been budgeted for such purposes.

E. The clerk of the board of supervisors shall maintain in a separate file all ordinances establishing and adjusting supervisors' salaries.

SECTION 2: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by amending Title 3, Chapter 3.060, Section 3.060.021 to read in its entirety as follows:

3.060.021 Salary for Members of the Board of Supervisors.

As of February 13, 2021, the biweekly salary for members of the board of supervisors of the County of Glenn shall be \$1,608.00. The Chair of the board of supervisors shall receive an additional biweekly stipend of fifty (\$50) dollars.

SECTION 3: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by amending Title 3, Chapter 3.060, Section 3.060.022 to read in its entirety as follows:

3.060.022 Adjustment of Supervisors' Salaries.

Commencing on January 2, 2022, and on the second day of January of each year thereafter, the salary of all members of the board of supervisors shall be adjusted upward, without any further action of the board, commensurate with the percentage increase of the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) established by the United States Social Security Administration.

SECTION 4: Uncodified Ordinance Number 1181 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 5: The Glenn County Code is amended by repealing section 3.060.023 of Chapter 3.060 in its entirety.

SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 7: Pursuant to California Government Code section 25123.5, this ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after the date of its adoption and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of passage thereof shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Glenn, State of California, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same.

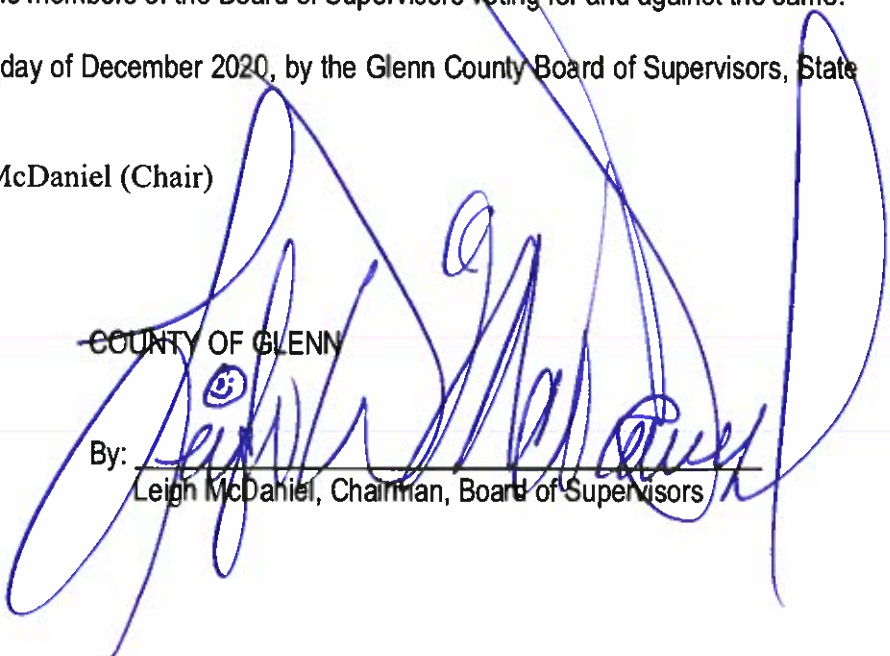
