

ORDINANCE NO. 1303

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF GLENN AMENDING THE GLENN COUNTY CODE BY
AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 11.090, SECTIONS 11.090-030 AND 11.090-040 RELATING
TO USE RESTRICTIONS ON COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GLENN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by amending Title 11, Chapter 11.090, Section 11.090-030 to read in its entirety as follows:

11.090-030 Designation of Truck Routes

Routes designated as Truck Routes shall not be restricted in use for driving, operating, or towing by commercial vehicles with legal loads. The following are designated as Truck Routes:

(a) All County Roads and road segments located outside of the Spheres of Influence of the City of Orland and the City of Willows; and

(b) Those road segments that are located inside of the Spheres of Influence of the City of Orland and the City of Willows as designated below.

SECTION 2: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by amending Title 11, Chapter 11.090, Section 11.090-040 to read in its entirety as follows:

11.090-040 Commercial Vehicle Parking Restrictions in Residential Areas

No commercial vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating exceeding 10,000 pounds may be parked on any County Road, or portion thereof, within or on the frontage of any residentially zoned property in the unincorporated areas within the Spheres of Influence for the City of Orland or the City of Willows. (California Vehicle Code Section 22507.5)

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of passage thereof shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Glenn, State of California, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same.

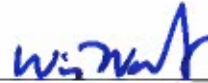
