

ORDINANCE NO. 1312

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF GLENN AMENDING THE GLENN COUNTY CODE BY AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 300 RELATING TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR AND ADDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 310 RELATING TO THE COUNTY SURVEYOR

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GLENN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by amending Title 2, Chapter 300 to read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 02.300

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR

Sections:

- 02.300.030** *Abolishment of Position of Road Commissioner*
- 02.300.040** *Duties.*
- 02.300.050** *Authority to Accept Road Right-of-Way.*

02.300.010 Office Created.

There is created in and for the county, the office of public works director.

02.300.020 Appointment and Removal.

The public works director shall be appointed by the board of supervisors, shall serve at the pleasure of the board of supervisors, and may be removed by a majority of the board of supervisors without cause at any regular meeting.

02.300.030 Abolishment of Position of Road Commissioner.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the board of supervisors by section 2006.4 of the California Streets and Highways Code, the position of road commissioner is hereby abolished, and the duties of the road commissioner imposed by law are transferred to the public works director. The public works director shall not be required to have any special permit, registration, or license to fulfill the duties of the road commissioner and any civil engineering functions that are required to be performed by the road commissioner shall be performed by a registered civil engineer acting under the authority of the public works director.

02.300.040 Duties.

The public works director shall, in addition to the duties imposed by law as road commissioner, be responsible for all public works, airports, roads, and solid waste disposal in the unincorporated area of the County of Glenn.

02.300.050 Authority to Accept Road Right-of-Way.

A. The public works director is designated by the board of supervisors pursuant to Section 941(d) of the Streets and Highways Code to accept, on behalf of the board of supervisors, roads or portions thereof, into the county road system and to record conveyances to the county of real property interest for road uses and purposes. The public works director shall report all acceptances and recordings to the board of supervisors at the end of each fiscal year.

B. Pursuant to section 66463(b) of the Government Code, the county public works director shall have the authority to approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove parcel maps and shall have the authority to accept or reject dedications and offers of dedications that are made by a statement on the map.

SECTION 2: The Glenn County Code is hereby amended by adding Title 2, Chapter 310 to read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 02.310
COUNTY SURVEYOR

Sections:

- 02.310.010** *Position Created.*
- 02.310.020** *Appointment and Removal.*
- 02.310.030** *Qualifications.*
- 02.310.040** *Office of the County Surveyor.*

02.310.010 Office Created.

There is created in and for the county, the office of county surveyor. The county surveyor shall be the ex officio division head of the county surveyor division of the public works department. The county surveyor shall act under the authority and under the general supervision of the public works director.

02.310.020 Appointment and Removal.

The county surveyor shall be appointed by the board of supervisors, shall serve at the pleasure of the board of supervisors, and may be removed by a majority of the board of supervisors without cause at any regular meeting. The election laws of the State of California shall not be applicable to the county surveyor.

02.310.030 Qualifications.

The county surveyor shall have the qualifications and licensure of a professional land surveyor as set forth in chapter 15 of division 3 (commencing with section 8700) of the Business and Professions Code.

02.310.040 Duties.

The county surveyor shall have, in addition to the duties imposed by law, those duties as set forth in Chapter 11 of Part 3, Division 1 (commencing with section 27550) of the Government Code and those duties set forth in sections 9022, 8507, and 795 of the Streets and Highways Code.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of passage thereof shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Glenn, State of California, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same.
