

ORDINANCE NO: O-2022-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE HIGHLAND CITY COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 3- 621 PARK OR PLANTER STRIPS OF THE HIGHLAND CITY DEVELOPMENT AS SHOWN IN FILENAME TA-22-17.

WHEREAS, all due and proper notices of public hearings and public meetings on this Ordinance held before the Highland City Planning Commission (the "Commission") and the Highland City Council (the "City Council") were given in the time, form, substance and manner provided by Utah Code Section 10-9a-205; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on this Ordinance on October 25, 2022 and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on this Ordinance on November 1, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Highland City Council as follows:

SECTION 1: ADOPTION Several sections of the Development Code are hereby amended as shown on "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.


SECTION 2: REPEALER CLAUSE All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinances a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.


SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from November 1, 2022 and after the required approval and publication according to law.

EXHIBIT A

3-621 Park Or Planter Strips

All park strip areas, the area between the sidewalk and the curb, shall be landscaped and maintained by the property owner directly adjacent to that sidewalk using traditional and /or Xeriscape methods. Vegetation such as grasses, flowers, ground covers and shrubs shall not exceed 22-inches in height. Vegetation shall not include weeds identified on the State of Utah Department of Agriculture and Food Designated Noxious Weed List for Colorado (CO), Idaho (ID), Kansas (KS), Montana (MT), Nebraska (NE), North Dakota (ND), South Dakota (SD), Utah (UT), Wyoming (WY) but may include approved drought tolerant plants.

1. The park strip may be covered with non-living material such as wood chips or decorative landscaping rocks (rock diameter of one inch minimum and six inches maximum) if commonly practiced xeriscape landscaping procedures are followed.
2. Trees planted in the park strip may be separated by non-living materials only if a water source is available at each tree (not from a hose, or above ground sprinkler).
3. Only trees from the city approved Class I Trees list may be planted within a park strip as follows:
 1. acer campestre; Hedge Maple
 2. acer ginnala; Amur Maple
 3. acer grandidentatum; Big Tooth Maple
 4. acer tataricum; Tatarian Maple
 5. koelreuteria paniculata; Goldenrain Tree
 6. prunus serrulata; Flowering Cherry
 7. prunus blireiana; Flowering Plum
 8. Pyrus fauriei, (syn. C. calleryana var. Fauriei) Korean Flowering pear
 9. Pyrus calleryana, 'Callery X Chanticleer Cultivar', Chanticleer (Callery) flowering pear
 10. Pyrus calleryana, 'Cleveland Select', Cleveland Select flowering pear
 11. Pyrus salicifolia, '>Pendula' (syn. Silver Frost') Weeping Willowleaf pear
 12. syringe reticulate; Japanese Tree Lilac
