**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-3-3, "SALE OF BURIAL RIGHTS," OF
TITLE 12, "PARKS, PUBLIC PROPERTY, AND RECREATION," OF THE
KAYSVILLE CITY CODE, AND AMENDING THE KAYSVILLE CITY FY 2026
CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE**

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.


SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE This ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City, shall become effective immediately upon posting.


