**A RESOLUTION RELATED TO THE OPERATION OF EV CHARGING  
STATIONS AND AMENDING THE KAYSVILLE CITY CONSOLIDATED FEE  
SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 RELATED TO EV CHARGING STATION  
FEES**

**WHEREAS**, Kaysville City operates 16 electric vehicle (EV) charging stations that are open to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Power Department has managed the EV charging stations since their installation; and

**WHEREAS**, these charging stations were originally installed using grant funds that also covered the associated operating and subscription costs through August 2025, and

**WHEREAS**, the City is now responsible for all ongoing costs related to the operation and maintenance of the EV charging stations, including utility expenses, subscription fees for monitoring software, and any necessary maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kaysville City Council finds it appropriate to establish user fees for EV charging that will recover the City's costs associated with providing this service, while maintaining public accessibility and encouraging the continued adoption of electric vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff has determined that the majority of these stations are located in City Parks and thus, the Parks Department is better situated to coordinate and administer the maintenance of these stations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kaysville City Council finds it in the best interest of the City that charging stations located within city parks be unavailable when the park is closed for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has prepared a recommended rate schedule that reflects the estimated costs of electricity, software subscriptions, and maintenance for both public and City use of the charging stations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kaysville City Council determines that it is advisable to amend the fee schedule to include the EV charging station rates proposed by staff.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the Kaysville City, in the State of Utah: 1. The City Council hereby amends the Consolidated Fee Schedule for Fiscal Year 2026. 2. Ownership and management of all EV charging stations is transferred from the Power Department to the Parks Department. 3. Charging stations located within city parks shall be unavailable for use during the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.

<u>Disconnect Charge (vehicles connected more than one hour after full charge) - Each hour</u>	\$5.00




