

**MILLCREEK, UTAH**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 19-19**

**AN ORDINANCE OF MILLCREEK AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE MILLCREEK CODE OF ORDINANCES REPLACING ALL REFERENCES TO FEE OR FEES AND A DOLLAR AMOUNT TO REFERENCE A CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE, AMENDING SECTION 2.24.060 REGARDING ADOPTION OF A NEW CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE, ADOPTING A CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE WORD COUNTY WITH THE WORD CITY, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THAT VARIOUS TERMS BE UPDATED TO REFLECT CURRENT USAGE AND IDENTIFICATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Millcreek Council (“*Council*”) met in a regular session on May 28, 2019, to consider, among other things an ordinance of Millcreek amending various sections of the Millcreek Code of Ordinances replacing all references to fee or fees and a dollar amount to reference a consolidated fee schedule amending section 2.24.060 regarding adoption of a new consolidated fee schedule, adopting a consolidated fee schedule, authorizing and directing the replacement of the word county with the word city, and authorizing and directing that various terms be updated to reflect current usage and identification; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has analyzed the current fee schedule and recommends the adoption of a new consolidated fee schedule; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City to adopt a new consolidated fee schedule.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council that all references to the words “fee” or “fees” and/or an associated dollar amount in the Millcreek Code of Ordinances, including but not limited to, sections 1.18.170, 1.18.185, 2.10.050, 2.24.060, 2.49.170, 2.73.020, 3.12.030, 3.12.040, 3.12.050, 3.42.010, 3.48.010, 3.48.020, 3.48.025, 3.48.030, 3.48.040, 3.52.010, 3.56.060, 3.56.070, 3.56.080, 5.02.060, 5.08.040, 5.10.030, 5.20.130, 6.10.110, 9.77.040, 9.88.050, 9.92.030, 11.26.040, 11.26.110, 11.26.140, 14.16.030, 14.16.040, 14.17.040, 14.17.14.48.040, 14.56.090, 15.08.040, 15.16.020, 15.20.030, 15.36.050, 17.22.040, 17.22.180, 19.05A.060, 19.92.040, and 19.94.070 be deleted and the words “consolidated fee schedule, which shall be on file in the city recorder’s office” or similar word depending on the context be inserted in lieu thereof and that the City Attorney and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this ordinance;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Council that the following be adopted as an amendment to section 2.24.060 of the Millcreek Code of Ordinances (designated by interlineating the words to be deleted and underlining the words to be added):

2.24.060 Fee Adoption

~~The city hereby adopts the current fees imposed by Salt Lake County for unincorporated areas for~~

providing government services and the same is incorporated herein by this reference. A consolidated fee schedule, to be known as the city consolidated fee schedule, is hereby adopted establishing fees charged by the city. The consolidated fee schedule may be amended from time to time by the city council and shall be kept on file in the city recorder office.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Council that the attached consolidated fee schedule be hereby adopted by the city.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Council that the City Attorney and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to replace all references to the word "County" with the word "City," where appropriate, that various terms be updated to reflect current usage and identification and that the City Attorney and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this ordinance.

This Ordinance, assigned Ordinance No. 19-19, shall take effect as soon as it shall be published or posted as required by law, deposited, and recorded in the office of the City Recorder, and accepted as required herein.
