

ORDINANCE NO. 953 (20)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 12, CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE A, SECTION 12-806 GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION REGULATIONS BY ADOPTING THE FEMA FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAPS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 15, 2021; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Moore, Oklahoma that Part 12, Chapter 8, Article A, Section 12-806, shall be amended as follows:

12-806. GENERAL PROVISIONS

B. BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

The areas of special flood hazard identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled, "The Flood Insurance Study for Cleveland County, Oklahoma and Incorporated areas" dated ~~February 13, 2013~~, January 15, 2021, with the accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this ordinance. However the current effective flood maps for the City of Moore identified by the "The Flood Insurance Study for Cleveland County, Oklahoma and Incorporated Areas" dated ~~September 26, 2008~~ February 13, 2013 shall be used for this purpose until ~~February 20, 2013~~ January 14, 2021.


**Severability**


If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be severable and unaffected.

**Repealer**

Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.

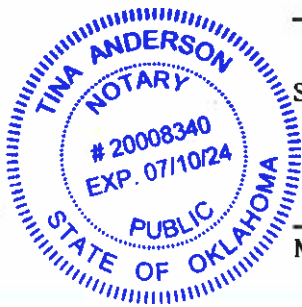
