ORDINANCE NO. 738(13)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 5, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE A, SECTIONS 5-501, 5-502 AND 5-504 OF THE MOORE CITY CODE, ESTABLISHING MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF MECHANICAL SYSTEMS, BY PROVIDING REASONABLE SAFEGUARDS TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY AGAINST THE HAZARDS OF INADEQUATE, DEFECTIVE OR UNSAFE MECHANICAL SYSTEMS AND INSTALLATIONS; KNOWN AS THE 2009 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORE THAT PART 5, CHAPTER 5, SECTIONS 5-501, 5-502 AND 5-504 ARE HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 5-501 ADOPTION OF 2006 2009 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE.

- A. That certain document, being marked and designated as "2006 2009 International Mechanical Code", as published by the International Code Council, Inc., is hereby adopted as the Mechanical Code of the city; for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of the 2006 2009 International Mechanical Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this chapter, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, hereinafter adopted.
- B. Subsequent revisions, modifications, codifications or editions of the code adopted herein shall become effective in the City as they are available, issued, and adopted by the City of Moore.

SECTION 5-502 ADDITIONS, INSERTIONS AND CHANGES.

- A. The code adopted in this article shall be known and cited as the city's mechanical code. All persons shall comply with the provisions of the code.
- B. The following sections are hereby revised as follows:
- 1. M-101.1 Title: These regulations shall be known as the Mechanical Code of the City of Moore, Oklahoma, hereinafter referred to as "this code";

- 2. Section 106.5.2 Fee Schedule: provided in the City's fee schedule;

- 3. Section 108.4 Violation Penalties: Insert: Refer to Moore City Code, Section 1-108. General and specific penalties; suspension or revocation of license or permit;
- 4. Section 108.4.1 Unlawful continuance: Insert: Refer to Moore City Code, Section 1-108. General and specific penalties; suspension or revocation of license or permit;
 - 5. Section 109.2 Membership of board: Amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created a Mechanical Board for the City of Moore, Oklahoma, which shall be composed of the building official of the city, who shall be ex-officio chairman of the board; a second board member who shall be a licensed mechanical contractor, a third member who shall be a licensed mechanical contractor, and a fourth member who shall be a licensed mechanical journeyman. The second, third, and fourth members shall be appointed by the city council for a term of two (2) years, and each shall serve until his successor is appointed and qualified unless sooner removed for cause. The second and third members shall have been actively engaged in such occupation for a period of not less than five (5) years immediately preceding the date of his

of not less than five (5) years immediately preceding the date of his appointment;

6. Section 603.8 is amended to read as follows:

Exceptions:

a. All ducts installed underslab shall be graded to access plenum or boot;

SECTION 5-504 PROVISIONS DECLARED TO BE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS.

The provisions of the International Mechanical Code, 2009 edition, in their interpretation and application shall be held to be minimum requirements adopted for the promotion of public health, safety and general welfare. Wherever any of the provisions or requirements of this code are inconsistent with the provisions of the city code or state statutes

presently existing or enacted in the future, the provisions or requirements containing the most restrictive regulation shall apply and govern.

<u>Severability.</u> If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be several and unaffected.

Repealer. Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.
