## ORDINANCE NO 778 (14)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 10, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 10-301, OF THE MOORE MUNICIPAL CODE AS SUPPLEMENTED (2013), BY INCREASING THE VALUE OF PROPERTY TO LESS THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00); REPEALING INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA THAT PART 10, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 10-301 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO INCLUDE:

## Section 10-301 PETIT LARCENY, AND LARCENY OF LOST PROPERTY

- A. No person shall steal, take and carry away by fraud or stealth, with intent to deprive another thereof, any personal property under the value of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or embezzle any money, personal property or effects of another under the value of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). This section does not apply to taking property from the "person" of another.
- B. One who finds lost property of the value of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or less, under circumstances which gives him knowledge or means of inquiry as to the true owner, and who appropriates such property to his own use, or to the use of another person who is not entitled thereto, without having first made such effort as the circumstances render reasonable and just to find the owner and restore the property to him, is guilty of a petit larceny.
- C. Repealer. Any Ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.
- D. Severability. If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be severable and unaffected.
