

**ORDINANCE 783 (14)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 7, CHAPTER 2, MOORE MUNICIPAL CODE (2013 SUPP.), BY ADDING NEW SECTION 7-211 PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV, SECTION 4-4, OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MOORE; PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTION IF A LEGAL AND SUFFICIENT REFERENDUM PETITION IS PROPERLY FILED; REPEALING INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

**Be it ordained by this Council of the City of Moore, Oklahoma that:**

**SECTION 7-211      SALE OF PROPERTY**

- (A)    The real property described as Lots 2 & 3, Oldtowne Industrial Addition, being a part of the NE/4, Section 14, T10N, R3W, I.M., Moore, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, also known as 1000 & 1004 Messenger Lane.

Owned by the City of Moore free and clear of all liens and encumbrances shall be sold to the best and most responsible bidder as determined by the City Council through advertising and receipt of sealed bids.

The City Council reserves the right to reject all bids and rebid the sale at a later date.

- (B)    This ordinance shall be referred to a vote of the electors of the City if a legal and sufficient referendum petition is properly filed within thirty days after its passage; otherwise it shall go into effect thirty days after its passage and publication.
- (C)    **Repealer.**  
If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be severable and unaffected.
- (D)    **Severability.**  
Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.
