AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 6, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 6-127 PAYMENT OF COSTS BY DEFENDANT, BY ESTABLISHING A TECHNOLOGY FEE, CONTINUANCE FEE, EXPUNGEMENT ORDER FILING FEE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER;

SECTION 6-127

PAYMENT OF COST BY DEFENDANT

- A. If judgement of conviction is entered, after the conclusion of a trial or by plea of guilty or nolo contendere in open court before the municipal judge, the clerk of the court shall tax the costs to the defendant in the maximum sum permitted by state law, plus the fees and mileage of jurors and witnesses, plus a technology fee, plus a fee for the filing of an expungement order, continuance fees, all of which the defendant shall pay, in addition to any fine may which be imposed.

Severability

If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be severable and unaffected.

Repealer

Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.
