

ORDINANCE NO. 864 (17)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 5, CHAPTER 11, SECTION 5-1102 (B) BY ADDING FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FEMA) PUBLICATION 361 AND INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL (ICC) 500 AS APPROVED CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR STORM SHELTERS; AND REPEALING ANY INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MOORE, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA THAT PART 5, CHAPTER 11, SECTION 5-1102 (B) IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

CHAPTER 11 - STORM SHELTERS

SECTION 5-1102 - PERMITS REQUIRED.

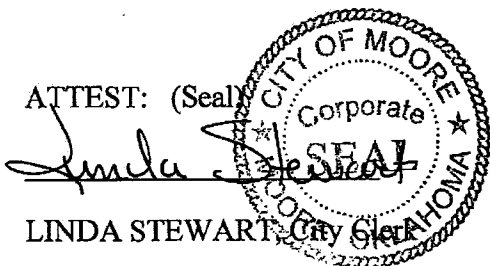
- A. No storm shelter shall be constructed within the city unless a building permit has been issued by the building inspection department.
- B. All storm shelter construction shall comply with the standards contained in FEMA Publication 320, FEMA Publication 361 or ICC 500 or the applicable succeeding publication(s).

Severability: If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be several and unaffected.

Repealer: Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.
