Ordinance #898(19)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA AMENDING SEC 10-405, PART 10, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE A; OF THE MOORE MUNICIPAL CODE (2018) OF THE CITY OF MOORE PROHIBITING POSSESSION OF CERTAIN OFFENSIVE WEAPONS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE City Council of the City of Moore, Oklahoma:

Sec. 10-405. Firearms and Carrying Certain Weapons Prohibited.

11

- A. No person shall transport a loaded firearm except in compliance with state law.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry upon or about his or her person, or in a purse or other container belonging to the person, any pistol, revolver, shotgun or rifle whether loaded or unloaded or any blackjack, loaded cane, hand chain, metal knuckles, or any other offensive weapon, whether such weapon be concealed or unconcealed, except as may be authorized by law.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge a firearm, air rifle or BB gun within the city except as may be authorized by law.
- D. Any person violating this provision shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not to exceed the maximum penalty established by state law.

CODIFICATION. The City Clerk is hereby directed to enter the added section into the appropriate place in the City of Moore Code as authorized and approved by this Ordinance.

SEVERABILITY. If any provision, paragraph, word, section of article of this Ordinance is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections, and chapters shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

REPEALER. All other Ordinances and parts of other Ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.


