PURPOSE OF ADDITIONAL ONE-EIGHTH OF ONE PERCENT SALES TAX. It is hereby declared that the additional one-eighth of one percent (0.1250%) sales tax levied by this Ordinance shall be in addition to the other sales tax levied by said Sales Tax Ordinance as may be hereafter amended from time to time, and the proceeds of such sales tax, or proceeds of borrowings by the City or a public trust of which the City is beneficiary payable from the sales tax, shall be expended on capital improvements and regulatory requirements, as determined by the City Council, including, to the extent legal and practical, the following projects:

Water system improvements, including but not limited to water line replacement, leak detection and modeling technology and upgrading city water wells, storm water systems and management, and drainage improvements.

- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Levy of Tax-This Tax In ADDITION Administration Procedures:</u> <u>Exemptions.</u> There is hereby levied an excise tax of one-eighth of one percent (0.1250%) upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales taxable under the Oklahoma Sales Tax Code, as set out therein. There is hereby specifically exempted from the tax levied by this Ordinance the gross receipts or gross proceeds exempted from the Oklahoma Sales Tax Code, as set out therein.
- Section 5. Total Effective Excise Tax. The rate of tax set forth in the Sales Tax Ordinance of the City of Moore, Oklahoma, is hereby increased to three and seven-eighths percent (3.8750%).
- Section 6. Amendments. The people of the City of Moore, Oklahoma, by their approval of this Ordinance at the election hereinabove provided, hereby authorize the City Council by Ordinance duly enacted to make such administrative and technical changes or additions in the method and manner of administration and enforcing this Ordinance as may be necessary or proper for efficiency and fairness except that the rate and limitation of time for collection of the tax herein provided shall not be changed without approval of the registered voters of the City as provided by law.
