

Ordinance #981(21)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA ADDING SECTION 210 OF PART 7, CHAPTER 2, FINANCE AND TAXATION CODE OF THE CITY OF MOORE FOR THE SALE OF SURPLUS GUNS, PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY.

ORDINANCE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE City Council of the City of Moore, Oklahoma:

SECTION 7-210 – Sale of property.

(a) The personal property described as 130 guns previously declared as surplus, owned by the City of Moore shall be sold to the best and most responsible bidder as determined by the city council through advertising and receipt of sealed bids. The City Council reserves the right to reject all bids and rebid the sale at a later date.

(b) This chapter shall be referred to a vote of the electors of the city if a legal and sufficient referendum petition is properly filed within 30 days after its passage; otherwise it shall go into effect 30 days after its passage and publication.

REPEALER,

Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY,

If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be severable and unaffected.




