

**CITY OF MOORE  
ORDINANCE 1005.22**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 11, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 11-310, AMENDING  
SECTION FOR REMOVAL OF FLOWERS AND OTHER DECORATIVE ITEMS**

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Moore, in the State of Oklahoma, as follows:

**SECTION 1:**        **AMENDMENT** “Sec 11-310 Removal Of Flowers” of the Moore Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

**A M E N D M E N T**

**Sec 11-310 Removal Of Flowers**

- A. It is unlawful for any person to remove flowers from a vase attached to the monument other than by the persons placing such flowers or by a designated city employee. The city will remove all flowers the first week of February and August.
- B. Flowers can remain in vases attached to the monument. Saddles with flowers, attached to the top of the monument, are allowed. Items such as glass jars, cans, or other containers used on the premises for the holding of floral bouquets are prohibited. Items on the ground or around the monument base and other prohibited items, such as rocks, metal rods, wire stakes, fencing, ornaments or other items that may cause maintenance problems will be removed during the first full week of every month.

**SECTION 2:**        **REPEALER CLAUSE** All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:**        **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE** Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinances a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.






