CITY OF MOORE ORDINANCE 1026.23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 15, CHAPTER 15-5, SECTION 15-514, AMENDING THE MAXIMUM FINE FOR RECKLESS DRIVING FROM \$200 TO \$500.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Moore, in the State of Oklahoma, as follows:

SECTION 1: <u>AMENDMENT</u> "Sec 15-514 Reckless Driving" of the Moore Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

Sec 15-514 Reckless Driving

- A. It shall be deemed reckless driving for any person to drive a motor vehicle in a careless or wanton manner without regard for the safety of persons or property.
- B. Any person convicted of violating this section shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 and shall pay court costs.

State Law reference—Similar provisions, 47 O.S. § 11-901.

- **SECTION 2:** REPEALER CLAUSE All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3: <u>SEVERABILITY CLAUSE</u> Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinances a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.
- **SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from 7/17/2023 and after the required approval and publication according to law.
