

ORDINANCE NO. 962 (21)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 7, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 7-519, MODIFYING THE LANGUAGE DESCRIBING USE OF FUNDS OF THE MOORE HOTEL/MOTEL ROOM TAX AS PREVIOUSLY APPROVED AND VOTED UPON BY THE CITIZENS OF MOORE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORE, OKLAHOMA:

Sec. 7-519. - Use of funds.

All taxes collected pursuant to provisions of this chapter shall be used for the acquisition and development of parks and recreational facilities of the city, as well as for operational expenses and capital outlays for repairs and maintenance of said parks and recreational facilities of the City.

Severability. If any of the provisions of this ordinance are determined to be unconstitutional or unlawful by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall be severable and unaffected.

Repealer. Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with this section are hereby repealed.
