

ORDINANCE NO. 19-24

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING AMENDMENTS REGARDING POLITICAL SIGNS TO CHAPTER 9 OF
TITLE 10 OF THE MORTON MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, the Morton Municipal Code was adopted on March 2, 1970, and duly published in book form; and

WHEREAS, notice has been duly published according to law, and a public hearing has been held pursuant to law regarding changes to the sign ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Morton Plan Commission has duly transmitted its recommendations to the President and Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MORTON, Tazewell County, Illinois, that Title 10 Chapter 9 Section 4 (S) of the Morton Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

1. In Section (S) 1., the words "unless they are on property zoned residential" are deleted.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as may be required by law.
