

ORDINANCE NO. 21-39

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AMENDMENTS REGARDING PARKING SPACES FOR EMPLOYEES IN INDUSTRIAL AREAS TO TITLE 10 OF THE MORTON MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Morton Municipal Code was adopted on March 2, 1970, and duly published in book form; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Morton desire to adopt additional regulations regarding the number of parking spaces required for employees in industrial areas within the Village of Morton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MORTON, Tazewell County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I: Section 10-8-6 (E) 1 of the Morton Municipal Code is hereby amended in the following method and manner with additions shown in bold underlined font and deletions shown in strikethrough font:

10-8-6 (E): Parking Required For Industrial Uses:

1. Manufacturing and industrial uses, research and testing laboratories, dry cleaning, printing, binding, publishing, assembly of materials and products, and other similar uses:
One (1) parking space for every ~~one and one half (1 ½) employees~~ **one employee** on the largest shift, including office workers.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as may be required by law.

SECTION III: If any section or part of this Ordinance is held invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.
