

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 8-203 OF ARTICLE II, CHAPTER 8 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN FROM REQUIRING CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL FOR ALL CONTRACTS EXCEEDING TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) TO REQUIRING CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL FOR ALL CONTRACTS EXCEEDING FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00); AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 1. THAT Section 8-203 of Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Norman shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8-203. - Purchases: City Council approval.

The City Council must approve all contracts for, or purchases of, supplies, equipment, or contractual services, where the valuation exceeds ~~twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00)~~ fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), prior to the signing of such contracts or the transaction of such purchases. Contracts and purchases valued between twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) and fifty-thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) that would otherwise be required to be approved by Council in this Section shall be reported to Council on a monthly basis.

* * * * *

§2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, except that the effective date provision shall not be severable from the operative provisions of the ordinance.
