

RESOLUTION 25- 25

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE BY AMENDING THE SOLID WASTE USER FEES FOR NORTH LOGAN CITY

WHEREAS, North Logan City has established a master fee schedule to list and regulate the charges for various services within the city; and

WHEREAS, the North Logan City has received notice of fee increases by Waste Management; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined there is a need to amend the Solid Waste Collection Fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of North Logan, Utah, that the Master Fee Schedule shall be changed as follows (highlighted portion added, crossed through items deleted)

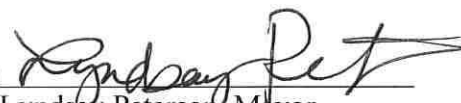
