NYE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 624

SUMMARY: An Ordinance Amending Title 3 Revenue And Finance Of The Nye County Code, Chapter 3.52 Public Safety Sales And Use Tax, By Amending Section 3.52.100 Approval Of Expenditure Of Funds, By Adding A Date For Plans To Be Approved By The Governing Body Of The Area To Which Those Proceeds Have Been Allocated For Expenditure; Providing For The Severability, Constitutionality And Effective Date Hereof, And Other Matters Properly Relating Thereto.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 REVENUE AND FINANCE OF THE NYE COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 3.52 PUBLIC SAFETY SALES AND USE TAX, BY AMENDING SECTION 3.52.100 APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, BY ADDING A DATE FOR PLANS TO BE APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE AREA TO WHICH THOSE PROCEEDS HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED FOR EXPENDITURE; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY, CONSTITUTIONALITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, a majority of the voters of Nye County approved Advisory Question No. 2 at the November 7, 2006, general election, indicating their support for an increase in the sales and use tax of up to one-half of 1 percent for the purpose of supporting public safety services in the County;

WHEREAS, during its 74th (2007) Session, the Nevada Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 461, wherein Sections 3 through 22, inclusive, are designated as "The Nye County Sales and Use Tax Act of 2007";

WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of Commissioners (Board) approved and implemented the Nye County Sales and Use Tax Act (Nye County Bill No. 2013-07) on August 28, 2013 which is now codified as Nye County Code Chapter 3.52;

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 244.119 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, to amend the Nye County Code;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Nye, State of Nevada, does hereby adopt, promulgate and order compliance therewith the following regulations:

1. CHAPTER 3.52.100 OF THE NYE COUNTY CODE IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

3.52.100: APPROVAL FOR EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS:

A. Expenditure of funds shall be approved by the governing body of the area to which those proceeds have been allocated for expenditure before April 15 and in accordance with subsections 3.52.070.D-E.

B. Plans for the expenditures from the proceeds distributed to support services provided by local fire departments and the sheriff shall be submitted on an annual basis to the governing body of the area to which those proceeds have been allocated for expenditure for approval.

C. The funds approved by the governing body of the area to which those proceeds have been allocated for expenditure may be pooled to provide shared service in the allocated areas, which services shall be performed or used in each area in accordance with the appropriate percentages for the allocated area to the extent feasible.

SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or amendments thereto, or the application to any person, thing or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or provisions or applications of the ordinance or amendments thereto which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance and amendments thereto are declared to be severable.

CONSTITUTIONALITY. If any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval, and publication as required by law, to wit, from and after the 23rd day of March, 2026.

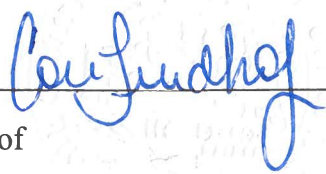
