ORDINANCE NO. 388

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11 OF ORDINANCE NO. 358 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, PERTAINING TO THE LOCATION OF BUILDINGS ON LOTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO:

Section 1: That Section 11 of Ordinance No. 358 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"In the business or commercial district, the buildings may be placed to the property line. But in the residential districts, there must be at least 20 feet between the front of the building and the property line, and a minimum width of 5 feet for the back yards and side yards from the adjoining property line. However, a minimum distance of ten (10) feet must be maintained from the wall to an existing or future opposing structure or obstruction.

"No structure of any kind which might obstruct the view shall be put on a corner lot of intersecting streets nearer than 20 feet from the street property line.

"The City Council has the authority to grant special exceptions to these rules when thought to be for the best interests to the public."
