ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGING OF FIRE CRACKERS, CANNON CRACKERS, TORPEDOES, FIRE ARMS, TOY PISTOLS, CATAPULTS, FLIPPERS OR ANY EXPLOSIVE TOY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I. That it shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any fire crackers, cannon crackers, torpedoes, fire arms, air guns, corporate limits of the City of Rexburg, Idaho; provided that fireworks may be discharged on the Fourth of July and such other occasion under such regulations and restrictions as the Mayor may prescribe by proclamation.

SECTION II. Any person violating any of the provisions of section one of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined in a sum not to exceed fifty dollars.

WHEREAS, an emergency existing, this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as by law provided.
