

**RICHMOND CITY CORPORATION
ORDINANCE 2022-08**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Richmond has the responsibility for the general welfare of the City; and

WHEREAS, such responsibility includes but is not limited to, establishment of best management practices;
and

WHEREAS, management practices may evolve over the passage of time:

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of Richmond City, County of Cache, State of Utah, hereby adopts, passes and publishes the following:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RICHMOND CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 12-000 “LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT (LUDMO)”, CHAPTER 12-700 “SIGNS”, PARTS 12-703 “EXEMPTIONS FROM SIGN REGULATIONS”, 12-702 “TYPES OF SIGNS” AND “SIGN REFERENCE CHART”.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF RICHMOND CITY, CACHE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

1. Sections shall be amended such that the highlighted areas below shall be added and the ~~strikeout~~ areas shall be deleted.

12-703 EXEMPTIONS FROM SIGN REGULATIONS

~~H. Election Signs displayed on any election day, advocating or opposing a candidate for public office or a position on an issue to be determined at the election located at least two hundred (200) feet from any entrance to a building in which a polling place is located.~~

~~1. These signs may be erected four weeks prior to the election and must be taken down within seven (7) days after the election.~~

H. Building Identification Signs indicating the name, date of erection, and history of a building not to exceed six (6) square feet and posted by public authorities.

I. Traffic Signs - All signs as required for traffic control as prescribed in the manual of Uniform Traffic Control.

J. New Construction Signs having an area not more than twenty-five (25) square feet, the message of which is limited to the notice of new construction, provided that the sign is temporary in nature and can be used for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days before initiating construction and must terminate fourteen (14) days after completion of construction.

B. Sign Designs Permitted in Richmond City

19. Election/Political Campaign Sign - Signs or posters announcing the candidates seeking political office and/or political issues, and data. These signs shall be confined to private property and located no closer than two hundred feet (200') to a polling place. Signs are not allowed on public property including the park strip, public right-of-way or any other city owned property. Signs must be removed within seven (7) days after the election.

2. Should any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, in whole or in part, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as whole, or any other part thereof.
3. All ordinances, and the chapter, clauses, sections, or parts thereof in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as is specifically provided for herein.
4. This ordinance shall become effective after the required public hearing and upon its posting as required by law.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be attached as an amendment to the Richmond City Municipal Code above referred to.
