10-19-8 Required Off-Street Parking:

The number of off street parking spaces provided shall comply with Table 19-1, Table of Off-Street Parking Requirements.

Table 19-1 - Off-Street Parking Requirements

Use	Minimum Off-Street Parking Requirements
Internal-Accessory Dwelling Unit (I-ADU)	1 space, non-tandem to the other required parking spaces, this space shall not be within the required front or side setback.

10-31-1 Purpose and Conflicts:


This Chapter provides definitions of general terms used throughout this Ordinance for which a definition is considered necessary. The words and terms defined in this chapter shall have the meanings as indicated.

Family: A person living alone, or any of the following groups living together as a single nonprofit housekeeping unit and sharing common living, sleeping, cooking and eating facilities: (a) Any number of people who are related by blood, marriage, adoption, or court sanctioned guardianship together with any incidental domestic or support staff who may or may not reside on the premises; or (b) up to four [4] unrelated people; or (c) two [2] unrelated people and any children related to either of them. "Family" does not include any group of individuals whose association is temporary or seasonal in nature or who are in a group living arrangement because of criminal offenses.
