Table 19-1 - Off-Street Parking Requirements

Use	(one) Minimum Off-Street Parking Requirements
Dwelling Unit, Internal-Accessory (I-ADU)	1 space, non-tandem to the other required parking spaces , this space shall not be within the required front or side setback.

10-31-1 Purpose and Conflicts:


Parking, Accessory: An additional approved hard surface parking pad typically located in the side yard or rear yard used to park recreational vehicles, trailers or additional personal vehicles.
