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Gen. Ord. No. 93 - 11 - 12. By Alderperson Dekker. April 16, 2012.

AN ORDINANCE amending, repealing and recreating various provisions of Chapter 26 of the Municipal Code, so as to combine the boards of electrical examiners and heating examiners into a new board of electrical and heating examiners.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Division 3 entitled "Board of Electrical Examiners" of Article III of Chapter 26, including Sections 26-291 through 26-298, of the Sheboygan Municipal Code, is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 26. BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATIONS

. . .

ARTICLE III. ELECTRICAL

. . .

DIVISION 3. BOARD OF ELECTRICAL AND HEATING EXAMINERS

Sec. 26-291. *Composition.*

The board of electrical and heating examiners shall consist of the following five members: One alderperson who shall be the chairperson of the board. The other four members appointed by the mayor shall be: one electrical contractor who shall be actively established in the electrical contracting business in the city; one licensed journeyman electrician; one licensed master or regular plant electrician; and one licensed heating contractor.

Sec. 26-292. *Qualifications.*

All members of the board of electrical and heating examiners shall have qualified in accordance with the requirements governing their classifications before confirmation by the council.

Sec. 26-293. *Terms.*

The alderperson member shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to confirmation by the council, at the first regular meeting of the council year, for a one-year term. The other four members shall be appointed on the third Tuesday in April for

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two-year terms, subject to confirmation by the council; provided, however, that the initial appointment of the electrical contractor member and the heating contractor member shall be for one-year terms.

Sec. 26-294. *Vacancies.*

Vacancies on the board of electrical and heating examiners shall be filled by appointment by the mayor, subject to confirmation by the council, except that the person appointed to fill a vacancy shall, if qualified, hold office for the unexpired term only.

Sec. 26-295. *Secretary.*

The electrical inspector shall act as secretary of the board of electrical and heating examiners.

Sec. 26-296. *Meetings.*

The board of electrical and heating examiners shall meet as required for the consideration of applications for license and such other business as may be before it.

Sec. 26-297. *Quorum; required votes.*

Three members of the board of electrical and heating examiners shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but no recommendations for the issuance, suspension or revocation of a license shall be adopted except by an affirmative vote of four members of the board.

Sec. 26-298. *Receipt of license applications.*

All applications for a license required by the provisions of this article and article V shall be referred by the electrical inspector to the board of electrical and heating examiners who shall properly investigate and report as to the qualifications and competency of the applicants in their respective classifications."

Section 2. Division 2 entitled "Board of Heating Examiners" of Article V of Chapter 26, including Sections 26-466 through 26-474, of the Sheboygan Municipal Code, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Section 26-522 entitled "Term; renewals" and Section 26-523 entitled "Revocation" of the Sheboygan Municipal Code are hereby amended so as to replace each and every instance of the phrase "board of heating

examiners" therein with the phrase "board of electrical and heating examiners."

Section 4. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.
