Gen. Ord. No. 91 - 11 - 12. By Alderperson Bohren. April 16, 2012.

AN ORDINANCE providing an exception to the City's noise ordinance for environmental remediation activities as part of the Sheboygan River and Harbor Superfund Project.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 66-72(8) of the Sheboygan Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

"Sec. 66-72. Exceptions.

. . .

- (8) Environmental remediation activities by or on behalf of a potentially responsible party as part of the EPA's Sheboygan River and Harbor Superfund Project."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.
