AN ORDINANCE repealing and recreating sections 10-64 and 10-112 of the Municipal Code, relating to closing times at licensed establishments, so as to align city closing hours with the provisions of state law.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10-64 of the Municipal Code is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

"Sec. 10-64. Closing hours.

- (a) The provisions of §125.32(3), Wisconsin Statutes, as amended from time to time, relating to closing hours, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference.
- (b) Between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m., no person may transport or carry out fermented malt beverages from Class "B" licensed premises in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises."

Section 2. Section 10-112 of the Municipal Code is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

"Sec. 10-112. Closing hours.

- (a) The provisions of §125.68(4), Wisconsin Statutes, as amended from time to time, relating to closing hours, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference.
- (b) Between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m., no person may transport or carry out intoxicating liquor from "Class B" licensed premises in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises."

Section 3. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.
