## ORDINANCE No. 03-17

### AN ORDINANCE MAKING AMENDMENTS TO SETBACK REQUIREMENTS IN THE C-O AND C-2 ZONES

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has enacted a land use ordinance to regulate the development of land within the City, establish zoning to protect property values, and establish administrative rules concerning land use; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the land use ordinance need to be made from time to time in order to remain compliant with state and federal law, become more efficient, and to keep standards in line with best construction and safety practices; and

WHEREAS, modifying front and corner setbacks in certain instances in the C-O and C-2 Commercial Zones will allow more of the types of businesses desired in those zones to locate and operate without creating any loss of aesthetics from slightly smaller setbacks; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Planning Commission on Wednesday, the 1st day of February, 2017, whereat public comment was received; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Spanish Fork City Council on Tuesday, the 7th day of February, 2017, whereat additional public comment was received;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

Spanish Fork Municipal Code, Table 2, Commercial and Industrial Development Standards, is hereby amended to allow smaller corner and front setbacks in the C-2 General Commercial Zone and the C-O Commercial Office Zone as follows:

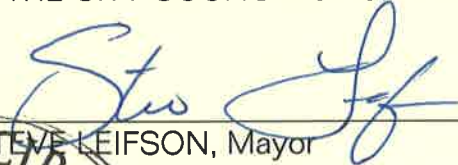

1 - Where range is indicated, side or rear setbacks are when the adjacent parcel is a residential use or district.  
 2 - Lower heights shown are for buildings and structures within 50 feet of a residential district or use.  
 Note: There is no minimum lot size, width, or lot frontage requirements. However, any new building or development must have permanent access on a paved road or driveway with a minimum width of 24 feet, with proper base material. Other improvements, such as curb and gutter, sidewalk, and additional pavement width or thickness may be required depending upon the nature of the business. (Ord. No. 07-04. Amended Industrial Zones Height Restrictions, 05/04/2004)  
 3 - The setback for self-storage units in the I-2 Industrial Zone may be reduced by the Planning Commission as noted in 15.3.16.130(E)(1).  
 4 - Fifteen feet, provided there is 30 feet from the building to the back of curb, otherwise 25 feet.  
 5 - Ten feet, provided there is 20 feet from the building to the back of curb, otherwise 15 feet.

II.

This ordinance shall be effective twenty days after passage and publication.
