

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.40.030 OF THE ST. ANTHONY MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE THE TIME IN WHICH THERE IS NO PARKING ON CITY STREETS DURING THE DESIGNATED WINTER SNOW PLOWING SEASON, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered past snow plowing and clearance practices of the City's public works department and how they fit into the period of time currently allotted for moving cars parked along the streets to permit clearance of snow; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after such review and consideration concludes that it would be a more efficient and effective use of the public works department time and less disruptive to those persons parking their vehicles on the streets to change the time cars are required to be off the streets during the winter snow season to one hour earlier in the evening than is now the case;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. ANTHONY, IDAHO THAT:

Section 1. Section 10.40.030A of the St. Anthony Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle so as to impede snow removal on city streets from November 1 through March 1 between ~~ten~~ nine p.m. and six a.m.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, execution and publication in the manner provided by law.
