**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER SEVENTEEN (“TRAFFIC SCHEDULES”) OF
TITLE TEN (“TRAFFIC”) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF
SUMMIT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(RESTRICTED NEIGHBORHOOD PARKING)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Summit, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of the Municipal Code of the Village of Summit when it is determined to be in the best interest of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined it to be in the best interests of the healthy, safety, and welfare of the Village to amend the text of the Municipal Code to regulate traffic upon the Village roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Summit, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Subsection L (“*Schedule XII*”) of Section 10-17-1 (“*Schedules*”) of Chapter 17 (“*Traffic Schedules*”) of Title 10 (“*Traffic*”) of the Municipal Code of the Village of Summit is hereby amended by adding the following new underlined language to read, as follows:

(L) Schedule XII; Restricted Neighborhood Parking: In accordance with the provisions of section 10-13-10 of this title, unless properly licensed, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets as follows:

1. 56th Street from 73rd Avenue to 72nd Court (Father Feurst Court).
2. 72nd Court, including that part of Father Feurst Court, from 57th Street to Archer Avenue. This area is designated as a towing zone.
3. 57th Street from 72nd Court (Father Feurst Court) to the west side of Harlem Avenue. This area is designated as a towing zone.
4. 62nd Place from 73rd Avenue going east until the dead end where the street ends.
5. 73rd Avenue from 62nd Place to 61st Street.
6. 63rd Place from 73rd Avenue to Harlem Avenue.
7. Center Avenue from Douglas Avenue north to the dead end by the railroad tracks.
8. On the north side of 59th Street from Archer Road east to the 75th Avenue intersection.
9. 7500 block of West Douglas Avenue between South Center Avenue and South Hunt Avenue.
10. On the south side of the 7200 Block of 60th Street between Harlem Avenue and 73rd Avenue

A fine of seven dollars (\$7.00) shall be assessed against any person, firm or corporation who is convicted of parking in a restricted neighborhood parking area without being properly licensed. Furthermore, all restricted neighborhood parking areas shall be designated as towing zones. Any car parked in the area designated as a towing zone may be removed and impounded pursuant to all procedures described by section 10-15-7 of this title

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval to ensure that the license herein contemplated is issued forthwith.
