ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 891

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 12.20-C, 12.20-D, AND 12.20-E OF THE UTAH COUNTY LAND USE ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE DUDE RANCHES AS A PERMITTED CONDITIONAL USE IN THE CRITICAL ENVIRONMENT (CE-1) ZONE

WHEREAS, an applicant initiated a review of Chapter 12 of the Utah County Land Use Ordinance (UCLUO) to include a dude ranch as a permitted conditional use in the Critical Environment (CE-1) Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Utah County Planning Commission addressed the proposed amendment to the Utah County Land Use Ordinance during the regularly scheduled meeting of the Planning Commission on September 19, 2021, held a public hearing regarding the proposed amendment, and made a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners regarding the proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received and carefully reviewed the recommendation from the Planning Commission regarding the proposed amendment, and the minutes of the Planning Commission meeting and the public hearing regarding the proposed amendment to the Utah County Land Use Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received and carefully reviewed the input, documents, and testimony from the public regarding the proposed amendment to the Utah County Land Use Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds the proposed amendment to the Utah County Land Use Ordinance conforms to the Utah County General Plan, and is consistent with the other provisions of the Utah County Land Use Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the proposed amendment to the Utah County Land Use Ordinance is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Utah County, considering all factors.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF UTAH COUNTY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Part I:

Section 12.20-C-9 of the Utah County Land Use Ordinance is hereby amended, including the appropriate re-numbering and re-formatting of applicable subsections, to add the following as a permitted conditional use in the Critical Environment (CE-1) Zone:

12.20: CE-1 CRITICAL ENVIRONMENTAL ZONE

C. PERMITTED CONDITIONAL USES

In the CE-1 Zone the following shall not be permitted by the Zoning Administrator unless approval of a conditional use has been authorized in accordance with this land use ordinance by the designated reviewing agency:

8. A dude ranch which has been approved as a conditional use by the Board of Adjustment according to the provisions of UCLUO 8.92 and UCLUO 16.

Part II:

Sections 12.20-D-1 of the Utah County Land Use Ordinance is hereby amended, including the appropriate re-numbering and re-formatting of applicable subsections, to read as follows:

12.20: CE-1 CRITICAL ENVIRONMENTAL ZONE

D. Area Requirements:

The minimum area of a zoning lot or parcel within the CE-1 Zone shall be as follows:

1. Each one-family dwelling, a private dog kennel on the same parcel as the dwelling to which it is accessory, dude ranch, reception center (with or without a one-family dwelling) planned subdivision, or major campground, shall be on a lot containing at least fifty (50) acres of land.

Part III:

Sections 12.20-E-1 of the Utah County Land Use Ordinance is hereby amended, including the appropriate re-numbering and re-formatting of applicable subsections, to read as follows:

12.20: CE-1 CRITICAL ENVIRONMENTAL ZONE

E. Width Requirements:

The minimum width of a zoning lot or parcel within the CE-1 Zone shall be as follows:

1. For each one-family dwelling or dude ranch, the minimum width of the lot or parcel at any point between the frontage and the structure shall be three hundred thirty (330) feet.

Part IV:

A copy of the Utah County Land Use Ordinance, as amended herein, is hereby ordered to be filed in the office of the Utah County Clerk/Auditor.

Part V:

If any of the sections, sentences, clauses or provisions of this ordinance shall for any reason be adjudged inapplicable or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such shall not affect or invalidate the remaining portion contained herein.

Part VI:

This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after it is passed and upon at least one (1) publication in a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Utah County.




