

ORDINANCE NO. 1998-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-18-B-2, ACTION TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT, APPROVAL, UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

PART I:

Section 7-18-B-2, Approval, of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

2. To reverse any order, requirement, decision, or determination made in administering or interpreting the zoning ordinance by any administrative official or agency; or to decide in favor of any appellant who has been denied a permit or approval according to the terms of the zoning ordinance and who has requested a variance; it shall require the concurring vote of three members of the Board of Adjustment.

PART II:

Other than the wording change for the stated section, the amendment adopted by Part I, shall not affect the remaining provisions and requirements of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance whatsoever, and such shall remain in full force and effect.

PART III:

Insert pages reflecting the above amendment, including a title page which bears the enactment date of this ordinance, are hereby ordered to be filed in the three copies of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance which are on file with the Utah County Clerk-Auditor.

PART IV:

If any of the sections, sentences, clause or provisions of this ordinance shall for any reason be adjudged inapplicable or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such shall not affect or invalidate the remaining portion contained herein.

PART V:

This ordinance shall take effect: 1) sixteen (16) days after it is passed, or 2) after it has been published, whichever date is later.

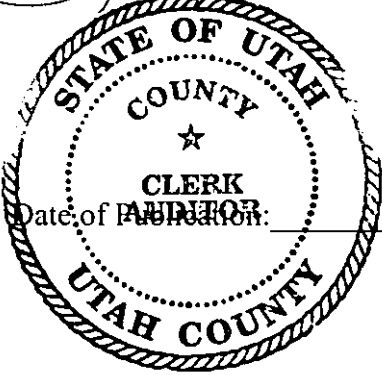
