

ORDINANCE NO. 1998 - 08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-1-E-17, ASSURING CONSTRUCTION OF REQUIRED IMPROVEMENTS OF THE UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL PARAGRAPH

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH
ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Part I:

Section 6-1-E-17, Assuring Construction of Required Improvements, of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended to add the following paragraph:

- e. All required street or road signs; including, but not limited to, street name and numbering signs, stop signs, yield signs, dead-end signs, information signs, shall be posted prior to any building permit for a structure being issued. Signs shall be posted from any entrance into the Large Scale Development from the existing county road, city street, or state highway, to the lot or site, providing appropriate location and safety information.

Part II:

Other than the wording change for the stated sections, the amendment adopted by Part I and Part II, shall not affect the remaining provisions and requirements of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance whatsoever, and such shall remain in full force and effect.

Part III:

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments, including a title page which bears the enactment date of this ordinance, are hereby ordered to be filed in the three copies of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance which are on file with the Utah County Clerk-Auditor.

Part IV:

If any of the sections, sentences, clause or provisions of this ordinance shall for any reason be adjudged inapplicable or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such shall not affect or invalidate the remaining portion contained herein.

Part V:

This ordinance shall take effect: 1) sixteen (16) days after it is passed, or 2) after it has been published, whichever date is later.



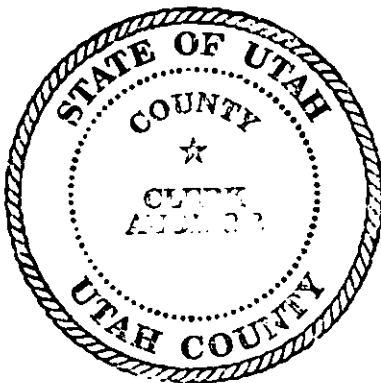
