

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-6-C AND 6-5-B OF THE UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE TO ALLOW PUBLIC SCHOOLS AS A PERMITTED USE IN THE RECREATIONAL RESORT, LARGE SCALE DEVELOPMENTS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

PART I

Section 5-6-C [Permitted conditional Uses, CE-2 Zone] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended adding new paragraph 14 to read as follows:

14. Public, primary or secondary schools, when included as part of an approved Recreational Resort, Large scale Development.

PART II

Section 6-5-B [Recreational Resorts, Permitted Uses] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended adding a new paragraph 11 to read as follows:

11. Public, primary or secondary schools, approved by a school district or state charter and when adequate safety services and infrastructure is provided as required for a school structure.

PART III

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments are hereby ordered to be filed in the three file copies of the Official Utah County Zoning Ordinance on file with the Utah County Clerk.

PART IV

This ordinance shall become effective: 1. Sixteen (16) days after it is passed, or 2. after it has been published, whichever date is later.

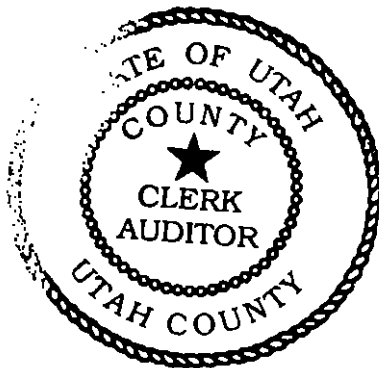


