AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-6-B OF THE
UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, TO ALLOW
FOR HOME OCCUPATIONS IN THE CE-2 ZONE

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Utah ordains as follows:

Part I

Section 5-6-B [Permitted Uses] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add a new paragraph 23 to read as follows:

23. Home occupations within the livable floor area of the dwelling, subject to the conditions set forth in zoning Section 3-36, with the exception that no patrons or deliveries are permitted.
