**THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**PART I:**

Section 6-3-E-9-b-ii [Water Quality] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add an exception to the end of subsection b-ii to read as follows:

However, the Zoning Administrator may, with the favorable review by the Utah County Health Department, approve the sampling of water from an existing well outside of the subdivision boundary, based upon the developer submitting a written finding from a Utah licensed engineer, stating the opinion, after studying the well logs of the proposed sampling well, that the sample will be representative of the aquifer to be utilized by the proposed subdivision; and further provided, however, that the proposed existing well is not located more than five hundred (500) feet from the subdivision boundary.

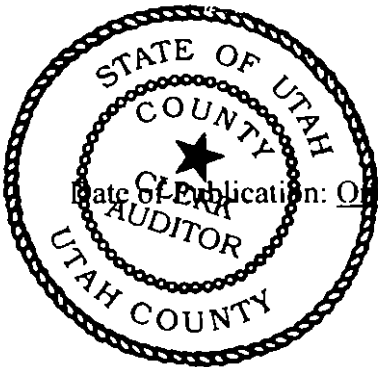


