Section 7-11-B of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

Both regular members and alternate members shall be administered the oath of office after being appointed but before taking part in any deliberations of the Board. An alternate member shall have full power to act in any capacity of a regular member when there are fewer than five regular members present. When there is a vacancy and more than one alternate member is available at the meeting, the Chairman of the Board of Adjustment shall select which alternate shall sit with the Board. If, while deliberations on an agenda item are in progress, a regular member arrives, the regular member shall not take the seat of an alternate member until the next agenda item comes before the Board.

PART II:

Section 7-18-A of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

To take action on a request, the Board of Adjustment must have at least three (3) members participating in the deliberations.

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments are hereby ordered to be filed in the three (3) file copies of the Official Utah County Zoning Ordinance on file with the Utah County Clerk/Auditor.

PART IV:

This ordinance shall take effect 1. sixteen (16) days after it is passed, or 2. after it has been published, whichever date is later.

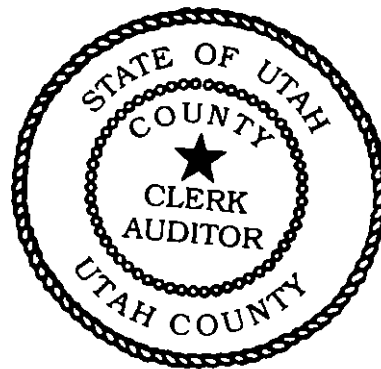
