

ORDINANCE NO 2002- 27

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6-4-E-7f, 6-5-E-8-c(iv), AND 6-6-E-7b
OF THE UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE
REGARDING THE PRIVATE ROAD STANDARD RIGHT-OF-WAY
AND PAVED TRAVEL SURFACE WIDTH**

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH

ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS

PART I

Section 6-4 E-7f [Mountain Home Development Standards - Street System] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows

- f All vehicular roads shall have a paved driving surface which is at least a twenty four (24) feet wide and which consists of a three (3) inch asphaltic surface over a six (6) inch crushed gravel base and suitable subbase, the paved driving surface shall be centered on a thirty two (32) foot wide road easement

PART II

Section 6-5 E 8-c(iv) [Recreational Resort Standards Street System] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows

- iv Each road shall have a paved driving surface which is at least twenty four (24) feet wide and which consists of a three (3) inch thick asphaltic surface over a six (6) inch crushed gravel base and suitable subbase, the paved driving surface shall be centered on a thirty-two (32) foot wide easement that is shown on the development s recorded plat

PART III

Section 6-6-E-7b [Mobile Home Park Street System] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows

- b All private streets shall be paved with a twenty four (24) foot asphalt surface and a curbing or storm water infiltration system which conforms to standards for private streets as adopted by Utah County, the paved driving

surface shall be centered on a thirty-two (32) foot wide road easement

PART IV

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments are hereby ordered to be filed in the three file copies of the Official Utah County Zone Map on file with the Utah County Auditor - Clerk

PART V

This ordinance shall take effect 1 sixteen (16) days after it is passed, or 2 after it has been published, whichever date is later

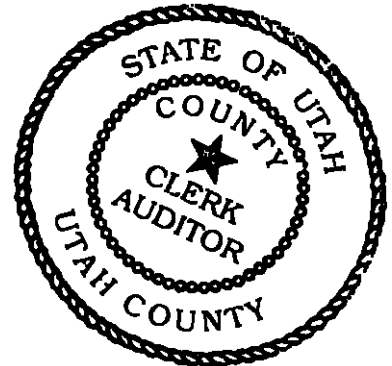

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6-4-E-7I 6-5-E-8-c(iv) AND 6-6-E-7b OF THE UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE REGARDING THE PRIVATE ROAD STANDARD RIGHT-OF WAY AND PAVED TRAVEL SURFACE WIDTH

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH

ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS

PART I

Section 6-4 E 7I (Mountain Home Development Standards Street System) of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows

i All vehicular roads shall have a paved driving surface which is at least a twenty-four (24) feet wide and which consists of a three (3) inch asphaltic surface over a six (6) inch crushed gravel base and suitable subbase the paved driving surface shall be centered on a thirty-two (32) foot wide road easement.

PART II

Section 6-5-E 8 c(iv) (Recreational Resort Standards Street System) of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows

iv Each road shall have a paved driving surface which is at least twenty four (24) feet wide and which consists of a three (3) inch thick asphaltic surface over a six (6) inch crushed gravel base and suitable subbase the paved driving surface shall be centered on a thirty-two (32) foot wide easement that is shown on the developer's recorded plat.

PART III

Section 6-6 E 7b (Mobile Home Park Street System) of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows

b All private streets shall be paved with a twenty four (24) foot asphalt surface and a curbing or storm water infiltration system which conforms to standards for private streets as adopted by Utah County the paved driving surface shall be centered on a thirty two (32) foot wide road easement

PART IV

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments are hereby ordered to be filed in the three file copies of the Official Utah County Zone Map on file with the Utah County Auditor Clerk.

PART V

This ordinance shall take effect 16 sixteen (16) days after it is passed or 2 after it has been published whichever date is later
