AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, SECTION 2-2-B, DEFINITIONS, TO ADD THE DEFINITION OF "WINDMILL" AND TO DELETE SECTION 5-2-C-1, RA-5 ZONE, ELECTRICAL POWER GENERATION PLANT AS A PERMITTED CONDITIONAL USE

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Part I:

Utah County Zoning Ordinance, Section 2-2-B, Paragraph 145A [Definitions] is hereby added to read as follows:

A structure utilizing wind power for the pumping of water for agricultural use on the parcel of property on which the windmill is located, or for electrical power generation for a residence and other permitted structures and uses located on the subject parcel of property. [This definition shall not preclude a windmill which generates it's primary electrical power for use on the premise from selling the surplus to an electrical utility provider; provided that the design of the windmill is only to provide required electrical power for use on the subject parcel of property, and not for commercial electrical power generation. Any other wind generated electrical power facility shall be classified as an electrical power generation plant, not a windmill.]

Part II:

Utah County Zoning Ordinance, Section 5-2-C, paragraph 1, electrical power generation plant as a permitted conditional use in the RA-5 zone, is hereby deleted and paragraphs 2-19 of Section 5-2-C renumbered as paragraphs 1-18.

Part III:

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments, including a title page which bears the enactment date of this ordinance, are hereby ordered to be filed in the three copies of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance which are on file with the Utah County Clerk-Auditor.

Part IV:

If any of the sections, sentences, clause or provisions of this ordinance shall for any reason be adjudged inapplicable or invalid by a court of competent jurisdictions, such shall not affect or invalidate the remaining portion contained herein.

Part V:

This ordinance shall take effect: 1) sixteen (16) days after it is passed, or 2) after it has been published, whichever date is later.
